SOLICITATION RM-15-RFP-002-BY4-MA HAS BEEN AMENDED TO REFLECT THE
FOLLOWING:

Question No.	RFP Section	Question/Comment
1	SECTION C.1.2 & C.2.2	<p>Amendment 1, Question 3: Section C.1.2, "Is there a desired location besides metro accessibility in Washington, DC?"</p> <p>Answer: "It is a business decision that shall be determined by the proposed Offeror as to where to locate the CFAC. However, it must be identified and discussed in the Budget Narrative" (emphasis added).</p> <p>This conflicts with the original RFP, Section C.2.2, which states "Contractor shall demonstrate efforts to secure the designated Center space as soon as possible and no later than Ninety (90) days after award of the Contract. All delays in meeting this objective shall be reported to the DBH COTR" (emphasis added).</p> <p>Please clarify the inconsistency.</p>
<p>DBH RESPONSE: There is no conflict between Section Scope of Work C.1.2 and Section Specific Requirements C.2.2 based upon the Specific requirements depicted below:</p> <p>C.1.2 The Center must have or be Centrally located, easily accessible to Consumers by Metro Bus and/or Metro Rail.</p> <p>C.2.2 Contractor, at the time of Award, has not secured a location for the CFAC, then, pursuant to Section C.2.2 the Contractor shall demonstrate efforts to secure the designated Center space as soon as possible and No Later Than Ninety (90) days after the Award of the Contract. All delays in meeting this objective shall be reported to the DBH COTR. Once the contractor has secured a location, pursuant to C.1.2 the location must be Centrally located, easily accessible to consumers by bus or metro rail.</p>
