## Status of CBO Clinicians in Cohort 1 and Cohort 2 School Placements

Data as of 3/13/20

- In Cohort 1, 93% of the CBO clinicians are in their school placements and 95% of the Cohort 1 schools have both a completed School Strengthening Tool and Work Plan.
- In Cohort 2, 85% of the CBO clinicians are in their school placements and 85% of the Cohort 2 schools have both a completed School Strengthening Tool and Work Plan.


