# School Prioritization Recommendation

## Next Cohort for SY 19-20

### **School Data Set**

- All DCPS and DC Public Charter Schools, except
  - Cohort 1 Schools
  - Secure Facilities, Adult, & On-Line Only

### **Data Elements**

- OSSE At-Risk Formula
- Individual Education Plans (IEPs)
- Absenteeism
- Out-of-School Suspension
- English Language Learner (ELL)

### **Analytics**

- Use Average Z-Score
- Weight OSSE At-Risk Score equal to the sum of the other factors
- Use “All School Data” Set (vs. Schools by Category ES, MS, HS etc.)

# FY20 Proposed Budget Enhancement

## \$6 Million to Expand School-based Behavioral Health Services

- Builds upon Mayor Bowser's \$3 Million investment in FY19
- Expands to 67 additional public and public charter schools
- Creates new School Mental Health Graduate internship program
- Expansion of DBH personnel to oversee the school-based expansion
- The DBH agency is taking steps to plan their new FY20 procurement projects with OCP including any expansions as a result of the enhancement funding being approved
