FY20 Proposed Budget Enhancement

\$6 Million to Expand School-based Behavioral Health Services

- Builds upon Mayor Bowser's \$3 Million investment in FY19
- Expands to 67 additional public and public charter schools
- Creates new School Mental Health Graduate internship program
- Expansion of DBH personnel to oversee the school-based expansion
- The DBH agency is taking steps to plan their new FY20 procurement projects with OCP including any expansions as a result of the enhancement funding being approved
