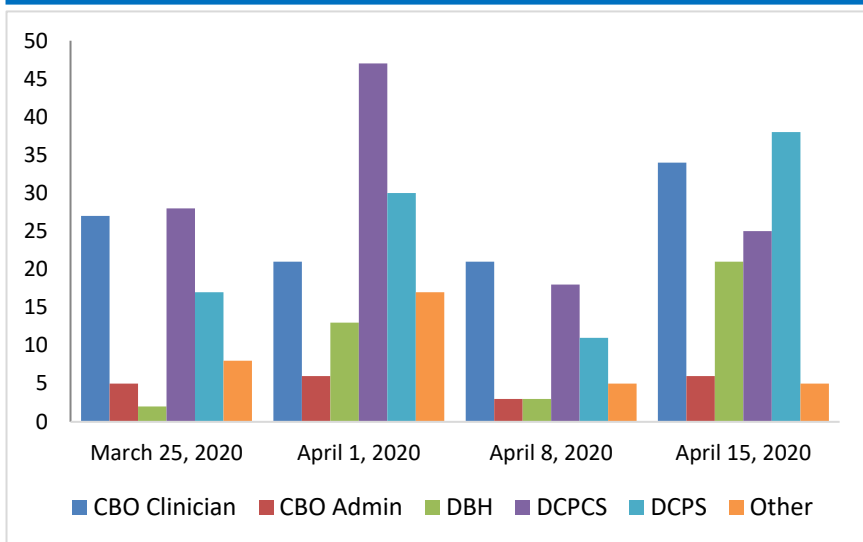

DC School Behavioral Health Community of Practice (CoP) Activities Update

Learning Activities and Brief Highlights from Practice Groups (PGs)

- There are five practice groups: (1) Crisis Intervention and Response, (2) Family and Youth Engagement, (3) School-Based Clinical Supervision, (4) School Climate and Social-Emotional Learning; and (5) Trauma-informed Practices in Schools
- Each of the five practice groups rotates the leadership in planning the content and learning activities for monthly DC CoP meetings (e.g., February focused Trauma-informed Practices; March focused on Family and Student Engagement)
- The School Climate and Social-Emotional Learning practice group is Leading the April 22 virtual meeting, focused on “Social and Emotional Learning: Beyond the School Walls”
- There is a new dropdown feature embedded in the DC CoP meeting registration so that we can build capacity of CoP members by matching participants with the practice groups of most interest to each of them
- Practice group leaders are taking an active role in facilitating the breakout sessions for informal CoP skill-building Chats, which are designed as a space to deepen understanding of the meeting content and apply new skills or learning activities to participants’ practice following each monthly meeting
- Due to the need for additional support during the pandemic crisis, the practice group leaders have become actively engaged in weekly CoP Chat activities.
