



**Bulletin Title: Licensed Practical Nurse and Registered Nurse Billing for Medication Somatic Treatment and Medication Management AMENDED**

On October 16, 2023, the Department of Health Care Finance (DHCF) issued [Transmittal 23-53](#), addressing rate changes for Medicaid-reimbursable behavioral health services, including Medication/Somatic Treatment and Medication Management. Following publication of the Transmittal, several providers have inquired to the Department of Behavioral Health (DBH) and DHCF of the role of Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN) and Registered Nurses (RN) in delivering Medication/Somatic Treatment and Medication Management services. DBH is publishing this bulletin to address these questions.

RNs and LPNs may bill the following codes for Medication/Somatic Treatment and Medication Management:

Evaluation and Management, Established Patient	99212	10 Minutes	\$69.26
Evaluation and Management, Established Patient	99213	15 Minutes	\$117.03
Evaluation and Management, Established Patient	99214	25 Minutes	\$164.80
Evaluation and Management, New Patient	99202	15-29 Minutes	\$105.09

Additionally, RNs may also deliver Clinical Care Coordination services as a component of Medication/Somatic Treatment and Medication Management services utilizing the following:
