



**Bulletin Title: Same Day Billing for Assertive Community Treatment and Rehabilitation
Day Services

Pursuant to [Department of Health Care Finance Transmittal 25-02, Same Day Billing for Rehabilitation Day Services and Assertive Community Treatment \(ACT\)](#), effective February 1, 2025, Department of Behavioral Health (DBH)-certified providers may bill for both ACT and Rehabilitation Day Services provided to a consumer on the same day when authorized by DBH.

Providers requesting authorization to deliver same-day ACT and Rehabilitation Day Services must follow established authorization processes. Specifically, providers should continue to forward authorization requests to the appropriate service-specific Sharepoint address with a complete Sharepoint questionnaire, the consumer's most recent Plan of care and a narrative statement for consideration and determination. DBH will process requests with complete documentation within 72 hours of receipt. To ensure the ongoing operations and oversight of Medicaid-funded behavioral health services, DBH providers should continue to adhere to the authorization procedures established in [DBH Bulletin 134: Changes to Consumer/Client Enrollment and Service Authorization Requirements](#), dated September 29, 2023, until further notice.
