The Smart from the Start, Woodland Terrace Family Success Center is part of a network of ten success centers located in neighborhoods across Wards 7 and 8 and operated by organizations that our communities know and trust.

Each center in our network is a bit different based on where it's located and who runs it. Our Center is staffed by people who know and love residents in and around the Woodland neighborhood and who are ready to serve anyone from across the city who comes through our doors.

PUTTING FAMILIES FIRST IN DC

Mayor Muriel Bowser's Families First DC initiative has committed 10 grants to community-based non-profits in Wards 7 and 8 to create five Family Success Centers in each ward. The Families First DC network will work with families to increase their overall well-being and the well-being of the community to give all families a fair shot in our rapidly changing city.
