Program Description:	The establishment of four (4) DC Prevention Centers: one (1) in Wards 1 & 2; one (1) in Wards 3 & 4; one (1) in Wards 5 & 6; and one (1) in Wards 7 & 8, in the District of Columbia to prevent the early onset of alcohol, tobacco, and other drug (ATOD) use while reducing risk and increasing protective factors for children and youth.
Eligible Applicants:	1. Non-profit or community-based organizations (Only one [1] application per organization will be accepted); 2. Organizations with an established physical presence (office location, program activities, etc.) in the District of Columbia within the proposed Wards; and/or 3. Current DCPC grant recipients are eligible to apply as long as they have an established physical presence within one of the proposed Wards.
