DMH RESPONSE: DMH has established a rate for Evidence-Based Supported Employment					

Services as stated in the Solicitation. An Agency's staff salaries, benefits and other costs must be factored into that rate. In addition, DMH funds services provided to consumers and does not pay for travel expenses, meals or other costs related to operating a program.

4	G.2.1.2. has a procedure code as H203. Most other procedure codes in the DMH Claims Section are one (1) letter and four (4) numbers. Is this H203 the correct procedure code?

DMH RESPONSE: The procedure code listed in G.2.1.5 is incorrect. The correct procedure code is H2023.

5	G.2.1.5 has a sixty (60) day deadline for claims submission. The standard submission for DMH claims (as well as other insurance payers) has been Ninety (90) Days. Could the Sixty (60) Day deadline be changed to a Ninety (90) Day deadline to be in line with the general practices of claims submission?

DMH RESPONSE: The standard submission for DMH claims is 90 days. The deadline for submission of Evidence-Based Supported Employment claims will also be Ninety (90) days.
