REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) AMENDMENT NUMBER FOUR (4)

Solicitation Number: RM-12-RFP-093-BY3-IT-iCAMS-TH

To All Prospective Bidders:

Solicitation **RM-12-RFP-093-BY3-IT-iCAMS-TH** is hereby amended as follows:

1. **Amendment Two, Question Thirty-Five**, How many prescribers will be using the software to submit electronic prescriptions?

Previous Response: It is roughly estimated that there will be 2,000 – 2,500 end users with varying designations (i.e. clinical, billing, administrative, other).

Amendment Two, Question Thirty Five previous response shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following: It is estimated that there will be between 200 – 250 iCAMS e-prescribers.

2. **Amendment Three, Question One**, Referencing Section 9.8.12, how is DMH using IBM/file Net today? What is anticipated?

Previous Response: Please refer to Appendix G: Proposed Interface Concept. In addition, please note that applications currently in use, scheduled to be replaced by iCAMS, does not interface with FileNet.

Amendment Three, Question One previous response shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following: Please refer to Appendix G: Proposed Interface Concept.

Please also note that applications currently in use, scheduled to be replaced by iCAMS, do not interface with FileNet.

3. **Amendment Three, Question Two**, C.8.2.25 – please clarify “835 Out.”

Previous Response: DMH envisions having the capability of claim re-adjudication realm and to have the capability of generating an 835 out to the Provider of Service should the payor/insurer need to be changed. The 835 Electronic Remittance Advice (ERA) provides information for the payee regarding claims in their final status, including information about the payee, the payer the amount, and any payment identifying information.

Amendment Three, Question Two previous response shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following: DMH envisions having claim re-adjudication capability. iCAMS would be capable of generating an 835 out to the Provider of Service should the payor/insurer need to be changed or adjusted. The 835 Electronic Remittance Advice (ERA) provides information for the payee regarding claims in their



final status, including information about the payee, the payer, the amount, and any payment identifying information.

4. Amendment Three, Question Four, C.8.10.36.1 – please clarify and provide an example.

Previous Response: The offered System should be able to “Stop” a claim from being submitted for payment if the approval process has not been fulfilled, i.e. if Jane Doe services a service: “Med Somatic” but the Doctor has not signed the clinical documentation for that service, that service would not yet be “complete” and subsequently “billable”.


Amendment Three, Question Four previous response shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following: The offered System should be able to “stop” a claim from being submitted for payment if the approval process as defined has not been fulfilled, i.e. if Jane Doe receives a service: “Med Somatic” but the doctor has not signed/approved the clinical documentation for that service, that service would not be deemed “complete” by iCAMS and subsequently would be “non-billable” until completed and approved.

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL REMAIN UNCHANGED.

Only one copy of this amendment is being sent to prospective Offerors. Offerors shall sign below and attach a signed copy of this amendment to each proposal to be submitted to the place specified for receipts of proposals. Proposals shall be mailed or delivered in accordance with the instructions provided in the original RFP. In the event your proposal has been previously deposited with the Department of Mental Health, Contracts and Procurement Administration (DMH/CPA), submit this signed Amendment in a sealed envelope, identified on the outside by the RFP number and submission date. This signed Amendment must be received by the DMH/CPA no later than the date and time for closing.

Failure to acknowledge receipt of Amendment Four (4) for Solicitation Number RM-12-RFP-093-BY3-IT-iCAMS-TH may be cause for rejection of any proposal submitted in response to the subject RFP.
