Program Description:	The DBH is seeking a provider to deliver 24-hr supervised youth residential substance use disorder (SUD) treatment services, also known as clinically managed medium- intensity residential services, Level 3.5, to no more than 16 youth (both males and females) aged 21 and under who are experiencing serious psychological, social issues and significant challenges in their daily functioning due to SUD.
Eligible Applicants:	Eligible applicants must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The provider shall possess SUD certification to provide Level 3.5, Clinically Managed Medium Intensity Residential (Youth) or have an application submitted within ninety (90) days of grant award. • Located in the District of Columbia. • The provider shall possess or become empaneled with all Medicaid Managed Care Plans within the District of Columbia within 180 days of the award. The provider shall

	provide the program manager with documentation confirming that it is empaneled with all managed care organizations within the District.
