





1. Admissions to SEH



2. Discharges from SEH




3. Average Daily Census



6. Unusual Incidents





7. Patient-Involved Unusual Incidents





8. Elopements




^{*} Elopement Rate: Number of elopements that occurred for every 1000 inpatient days.









13. Likely Involuntary Emergency Medications



14. Percent of Missing Documentation on Med-Administration




15. Percent of Patients Restrained or Secluded
