125-BY0-DJW for MATTRESSES FOR SAINT ELIZABETHS HOSPITAL**

TO ALL PROSPECTIVE OFFERORS:

The above referenced Request for Quotations (RFQ) is hereby amended as follows:

| 1. | C | Concerning the above referenced RFQ, I have a question. We are a manufacturer of mattresses for the medical, detention, military, and university sectors. Most of our mattresses feature 100% RF Welded seams. We do make the inverted sewn seams as well. However, many behavioral health facilities have switched over to the welded seam construction in order to get a mattress that has health and safety advantages. They also are more durable because the fabric is a TPU Nylon versus a vinyl. The fabric can be washed with a water hose if they desire without having any effect on the fabric. The safety advantage is that a patient cannot access the core of the mattress by cutting or chewing the threads in the seam, since it does not have any. With welded seams, the core of the mattress is impervious to bed bugs, body lice, body fluids, bacteria, or any other contaminant. We warrant the welded seams for 5 years. We currently sell this mattress to many behavioral health facilities including the state mental health facilities in North Carolina under a contract. Would this mattress be acceptable to the facility and should we quote this particular one or stay with a sewn version? |

DBH RESPONSE:

Saint Elizabeths Hospital (SEH) deems that welded seam construction mattresses shall fit SEH current needs.

SEH requires that all One Hundred (100) Mattresses be delivered at one time.

In this Solicitation, Subcontractor is one who takes a portion of a Contract from the Principal Contractor or from another Subcontractor.


